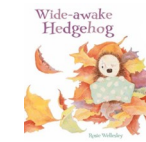


Our Focus Texts:

Communication and Language

We will be building our listening and attention skills in school, learning new routines/ rules and how to follow instructions. We will share our likes and dislikes with others. We will talk about our families and pets and learn about our friends in Chestnut Class.

We will begin to talk about what we can see around us, using our senses to explore the world. We will take in turns and play memory games with our friends.

PSED

We will be exploring our emotions and how we can tell a grown-up and our friends how we are feeling. We will be building new friendships and learning how to take in turns and be a kind friend to everyone in Chestnut Class.

Understanding the World

This term, we will be learning about ourselves, our senses and how we are all different.

We will learn all about the Autumn season, going for Autumn walks to investigate signs of the new season. We will find out why animals hibernate and what we could do to help hedgehogs prepare for winter.

Expressive Art and Design

We will explore colour and different materials we can use to mark make. We will mix colours to paint and look at making puppets. On our 'Welly Walks', we will look at using natural materials to create collages of hedgehogs.

In music we will explore songs we like.

Literacy

This term, we will look at letter formations and how to write our names. We will begin to look at Phase 2 Letters and Sounds and start to build our awareness of phonics. We will use our sounds to help us try to write about what we like and what we can see. We will begin to use our 'sound talk' and 'robot arms' to read simple words.

Physical Development

Everyday we will be developing our strong fine motor skills through 'Squiggle Wiggle' activities in our classroom.

We will explore moving in different ways, finding spaces and avoiding obstacles.

Technology

We will use iPads to take photos of collages we make with natural materials.

Maths

We follow The White Rose Maths Scheme in Chestnut Class. This term we will look at building routines and learn where items belong in our classroom. We will be looking at sorting and matching objects and finding ways to group items into pairs. We will create a bar graph in our class to show what pets we all have and begin to explore sizes, mass and capacity. We will look at representing and counting to 5 and begin to mark make and record this in our own way. We will explore 2D shapes and try to find them.
