As Citizens we will: Follow our RE programme of study and in PHSE we will learn about

- Rights, needs and responsibilities.
- Community participation and fund-raising activities.
- Growing and caring for ourselves.
- Healthy eating and exercise.
- Valuing differences.
- Keeping safe.

As Linguists we will:

- Read with increasing fluency for purpose and pleasure.
- Use phonetic knowledge to decode and read and increasing breadth words and phrases.
- Participate in discussions, presentations, performance, role play and debates.
- Identify features of traditional tales and poetry.
- Explore descriptive writing.

As Geographers we will:

Use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to:

- key physical features of land and coasts.
- key human features, including city, town village.

In Geographical skills and field work we will use compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational and directional language (for example, near and far, left and right to describe the location of features and routes on a map.

As Artists we will:

- Explore lines of different thicknesses with pencils and paint brushes.
- Name and use primary and secondary colours.
- Use paint to convey a variety of moods.
- Create collages.
- Focus on the work of Kandinsky.



Our Big Questions:

What would you like to have in your picnic?

Where does Katie Morag live and is it more exciting than Devon?



As Musicians we will:

- Use our voices to speak, sing and chant.
- Make different sounds with instruments.
- Recognise repeated patterns.
- Clap short rhythmic patterns.
- Compose and perform simple pieces

As Computer technicians we will:

- Learn about algorithms and programs.
- Create a simple series of instructions for movement including forwards, backwards, up and down.
- Plan and test a Bee-Bot (programmable device) journey.
- Record our Bee Bot routes.

As Scientists we will:

- Ask and answer questions, giving simple reasons for the answers.
- Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants including deciduous and evergreen trees.
- Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants including trees.
- Understand the life cycle of a sunflower.
- Identify and name a variety of common animals and birds.

As Athletes we will:

- Take part in weekly P.E lessons exploring ways to move and stay healthy.

As Mathematicians we will:

- Measure length, height, weight, and capacity.
- Count in the patterns of twos, fives and tens.
- Multiply and divide.
- Begin to explore simple fractions.
- Focus on place value within 100.
- Further develop our understanding of shape and positional language.
