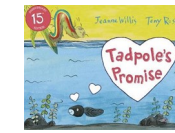
Are all minibeasts scary?

Communication and Language

We will learn and sing a variety of minibeast songs, rhymes and riddles and record ourselves performing them.

We will use talk to explain the life cycle of a butterfly to a friend and we will use positional language to describe where minibeasts are.

We will imagine we are minibeasts and use our 'hot seating' skills to ask who, what, when and how questions.

We will think of words to describe minibeasts, for example wiggly and fast, and create a word bank together as a class.

Maths

Everyday we will look at our number and shape of the day. We will build numbers beyond 10 and look at adding and subtracting.

We will create caterpillars using interlocking cubes, exploring length and using vocabulary such as short, long, shorter, longer.

We will look at ordering numbers from zero to twenty.

We will create our own symmetrical shape butterflies.

PSED

We will be thinking about how we can care for minibeasts and work with a group of friends to build homes for them. We will describe how we feel when looking at different minibeasts.

We will learn how to cross roads safely when going on an adventure around the village.

Understanding the World

We will learn about different minibeasts, where they live and how they protect themselves. We will work together to care for our class caterpillars, watching them grow into butterflies.

We will go on minibeast hunts in our environmental area.

Expressive Art and Design

We will explore clay and look at making minibeasts. We will create minibeasts using our fingerprints and will work with friends to create small world bug cities.

We will use musical instruments to create the sounds minibeasts make and dance to the music we create.

Literacy

We will continue our daily phonics sessions, applying our sounds to reading and writing.

We will write sentences and captions about minibeasts and create our own 'Minibeast Fact Files'.

We will create flip books all about the life cycle of a butterfly.

Physical Development

We will continue our fine motor activities each morning and look at handling tools safely.

We will look at building our athletic skills in PE. We will also look at how we can move like minibeasts.

We will continue to stay safe and remember to wash our hands throughout the day.
