**Dear Parents and Carers,
Welcome to the Autumn Term at Ipplepen in Year Two.**

Please find attached an overview of the main topics and subjects we will be covering in Year Two this term, as well as a copy of your child's timetable.

I would like to take this opportunity to let you know some important class information.

- PE will be on a **Tuesday** and a **Friday**. Children must come in to school wearing their PE kit as we will not be getting changed at school. If they would like to put shorts or jogging bottoms in their bag (in case they get too hot or too cold) then they can do so.
- Forest school will also be on a **Tuesday** afternoon with Mrs Kerr. Please make sure your child has a coat, wellies and waterproof trousers that they can wear outside.
- Snacks must be a healthy option. Please do not send biscuits, sweets or crisps as a snack choice. Fruit, vegetables or rice cakes would be fantastic. There will also be fruit available at school for the children to have if they would like.
- With the weather becoming unpredictable, please ensure your child has a coat in school. This must be labelled with their name.
- I will be sending you some information about Bug Club soon as this will be where the children will find their reading books. I will also be sending home a reading diary for you to fill in every time you hear your child read. Please use this to record when your child has read and daily reading is encouraged. It is encouraged to read the book at least twice to pick out any tricky words and discuss the meaning of any unfamiliar vocabulary as well as become familiar with the text itself. They should also be able to answer a variety of questions that you ask them based on what they have just read as well as predicting what may happen next or discussing how a character may feel.
- Homework will be set on Google classroom on a **Thursday** and will need to be submitted by the following Tuesday. I will send home log ins to make sure that you are all able to log in.
