Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to the Autumn Term at Ipplepen Primary Class Three.

- ❖ Please encourage the use of the 'reading diary'. The children *must* record their weekly reading in the diary. We will be monitoring this at school; your support will be very much appreciated. Please could you sign at the end of each week to show you have seen this diary.
- ❖ Full school uniform is to be worn every day. Please note that the wearing of nail varnish is not permitted in school. Now the weather is becoming unpredictable please ensure your child has a raincoat.
- ❖ PE lessons are on Tuesday and Thursday. PE kit should be worn into school for these lessons.
- ❖ Homework is given out every Thursday and will be marked the following Tuesday. Do let us know if there are any problems regarding the homework, preferably before the day the homework is due in.
- ❖ Spellings will be tested on a Tuesday.
