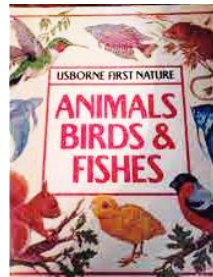
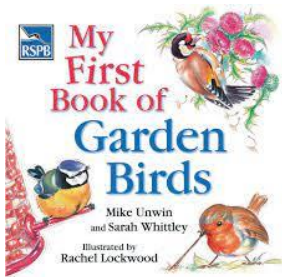


Week Beginning 24th January 2022

Linking to the children's learning last week regarding our current climate we talked about wildlife, in particular the birds. We started to make bird feeders using pine cones for the children to bring home and put in the garden. This week we will look at identifying different birds.



This coming weekend is the RSPB Big Garden Birdwatch, we hope that the children will join in with some bird counting. They will come home this week

with a tick sheet, if possible could you support them with their task. Please return the sheets and we will have a big count up to see the most popular birds we have in our gardens.

This week, the children will have the opportunity to design their own hats, gloves and scarfs using repeated colours and patterns.

The children have been watching the scene 'tidy up the nursery' from the film Mary Poppins and we are using the song, a spoon full of sugar, for our tidy up time at the end of the day.

We are trying to speed up the collection process by getting the children's coats and bags on them in advance. Please could you collect their lunch boxes and water bottles from the trolley outside and collect the children from the canopy gate.
