

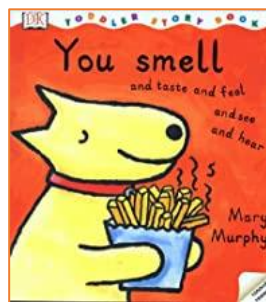
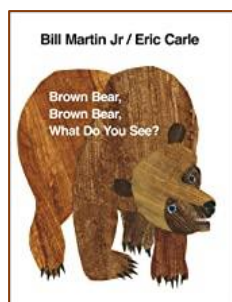
Week Beginning 14th March 2022
