

Year 3 Summer Term 2022

Here is our topic for this half term. Please use this information to support your children's learning.

As Writers:

We will be writing explanations in the teaching sequence: Until I met Dudley. In the teaching sequence for Leon and the Place Between, we will be doing some creative writing and after that, persuasive letters.

As Artists:

We shall be looking at the skill of colour mixing through the work of William Morris. We shall be thinking about warm and cold colours and how they relate to each other on the colour wheel; seasons of the year and which colours they evoke. We shall be developing these ideas in print.

As Linguists:

We shall be having a weekly spelling lesson looking at rules of spelling and patterns.

As Computer Technicians:

We shall be using graphing to help us solve problems.

As Musicians:

Reflect, Rewind, Replay: We will be looking over some of the songs we have learnt this year and the music we have mastered. We will be able to consolidate learning and perform.

As Mathematicians: We shall be studying shape and space including different kinds of lines and qualities of 3-D and 2-D shapes. We shall also be measuring mass and capacity, adding and subtracting amounts, then looking at temperature.

The Big Question:

In Forest School:

We will be planting seeds and watching them grow, transforming the outside space. We shall also be having a day when we help to maintain the school environment.

As Athletes:

We shall be taking part in weekly lessons, continuing to apply and develop a broader range of skills, learning how to use them in different ways.

As Citizens:

We shall be celebrating our web of relationships by knowing how to express appreciation to friends and family and enjoying being part of these precious groups as we live our lives.

As Scientists:

We shall,

- identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers
- explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant
- investigate the way in which water is transported within plants
- explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.
