Begin to create games using our coding knowledge.

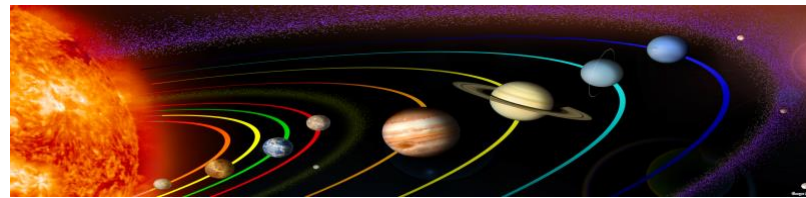
As Linguists we will:
