We would also like to remind parents and carers that the car park is for school staff only. Again, we thank you for your cooperation.



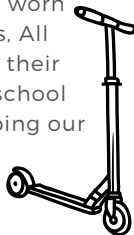
Professional Photos

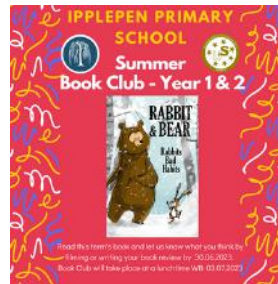
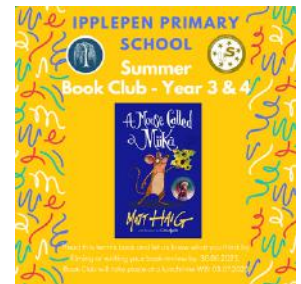
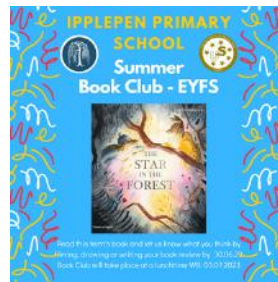


Messages for Teachers
