As readers we will:

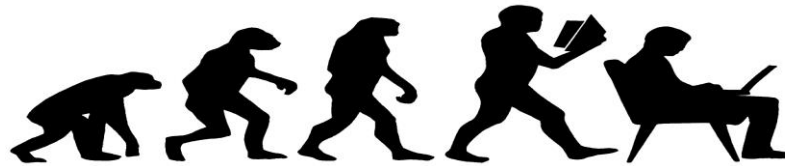
Listen to and read stories linked to our units and answer questions about them.

Find factors of numbers.
Revise mental and written methods for the four rules of number. (+ - x ÷)

As Artists we will:

Produce Self-Portraits...

Use accuracy and imagination when drawing.

Explain our choice of different tools and techniques when drawing.

Manipulate a range of materials to produce outcomes in differing mediums. We will produce a 3D Collage of our face.

Write for a range of audiences, changing our sentence structure to suit.
Write setting and character descriptions.
Write non-chronological reports linked to our topic and inspired by our trip.
