As Linguists we will:

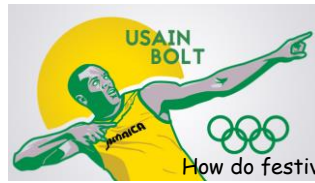
- Continue to learn French and improve our reading, writing, listening and speaking skills.
