Dear Parents and Carers,

Happy New Year and welcome back to the Spring Term of Year Five. We are really looking forward to what this term will bring and supporting the children to grow and progress. We will continue to raise our expectations of the children in order for them to improve their independence and prepare them for Year 6 and beyond.

### Staffing in Year 5

As you are aware, consistency and continuity is our priority. Therefore, Miss Webb will continue to teach Year 5 at present and Mrs Kerr will support in this class as their teaching assistant. We will be sure to notify you of any changes with this. We are also currently seeking someone to deliver additional tutoring to year 5 and when we have more information, we will share this with you. In the meantime, our usual interventions will continue, as they have done since the beginning of the year.

The children are responsible for:

- Coming into school equipped with all necessary items;
  - a bottle of water
  - a coat
  - their reading book and reading record
- Completing homework to a high standard and handing it in on time (due on a Wednesday unless otherwise stated). Homework will include;
  - times table practise – using TTRockstars and/or MyMaths





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- o a Maths task set on MyMaths/Education City (via Google Classroom)
  - o an English task set on Google Classroom
  - o reading - a minimum of three times a week (diaries checked on a Friday)
  - o spelling practise on 'Spelling Frame' – up to 20 words will be tested on Wednesdays

Please ensure all reading is recorded in your child's reading record. This can be done by either yourself or your child. We will be looking for evidence of reading a variety of text types throughout the year, so please help to encourage your child to look at a range of books. Children will need to complete their Accelerated Reader Quiz as soon as possible after finishing a book and will have the opportunity to do this in school every morning.

We understand that some children have a mobile phone with them to enable them to communicate on their journeys to and from school. We would appreciate your help in reminding your child to hand this in to the teacher on arrival at school, to be stored safely and they will be returned to them at the end of the school day. Please ensure we have received a signed form for this too.

Children will need to wear their PE kit (plain black/navy shorts, a plain house-coloured t-shirt and trainers) to school on a Tuesday and Friday this half term. They can also wear a plain-coloured jumper (not a hoody) and plain-coloured tracksuit bottoms or leggings over the top of this on colder days.

Outdoor learning will be happening on a Monday afternoon. Children will need to arrive at school in their school uniform and have appropriate clothing and wellies in a bag to change into at the beginning of the session.

Along with all of this hard work and developing independence, we will undoubtedly be having a lot of fun too with a range of different topics, activities and experiences. Information for each new topic will be sent out at the beginning of each term.
