

Year F Spring Term 2 Overview 2024

Should Goldilocks say sorry?

Literacy

This half term, we will practise using our phase 3 digraphs, developing some independence in our mark making. We will use the sounds we know to write labels, captions and short sentences related to the texts we are reading. We will try to use finger spaces and full stops in our writing.

We will create freeze frames of different characters from the books we read and we will record ourselves telling the story.

PSED

We will continue to use our Jigsaw Scheme weekly. Our focus this half term is 'Healthy Me'.

We will be talking about how we can stay safe, when around strangers and online. We will talk about how our actions make others feel and why it is important to say sorry.

We will think about rules for Goldilocks, explaining to her how she should behave around strangers.

We will talk about how we can safely make friends with new people.

Understanding the World

We will use our senses to help us discuss the changes involved in porridge making. We will explain how to make a cup of tea, thinking about the word 'infuses'.

We will learn about signs of Spring and talk about why we celebrate Easter. We will think about special buildings and why Christians visit church.

This half term, we are going to be learning about a variety of traditional tales.



Expressive Art and Design

We are going to make puppets, masks and props to retell the story of 'The Three Bears'.

We will design and create a new chair for Baby Bear. We will learn how to program a Bee Bot and give it directions.

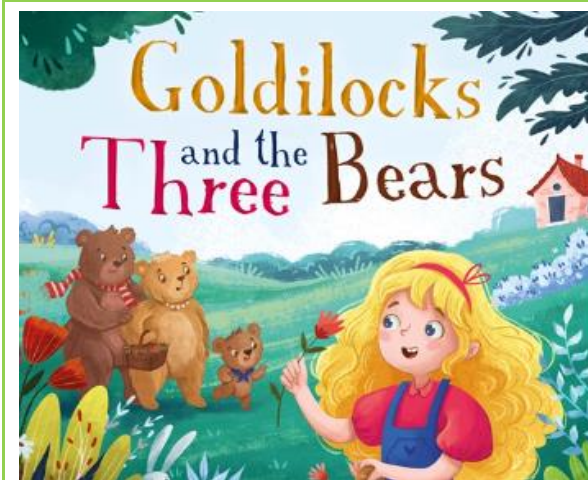
Maths

We will learn about 9 and 10, how to represent amounts in different ways and counting forwards and backwards. We will arrange items into groups and try to subitise larger amounts. We will spend time consolidating numbers 010, through games and practical activities.

We will print using 3D shapes and use what we know to design a chair for Baby Bear. We will measure ingredients to make porridge.

Physical Development

We will use tools and equipment safely, with some accuracy, when creating props. We will teach Baby Bear how to write his letters. We will talk about how we can support ourselves if we feel tired, hungry or thirsty. We will make healthy food choices and create some healthy recipes in class.



Communication and Language

This half term, we are going to be diving into traditional tales, focusing on 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'.

We are going to listen and respond to the story, answering questions about what happened whilst becoming different characters.

We will hold back and forth conversation with our peers using connectives in our speech.

We will talk about songs and poems and why we like/ dislike them.
